Volunteer In Mission Camp

What a week it was, we had up to 34 VIM'ers working at many tasks. The following is a list of jobs we worked on:

We built a new tree house to go with the two already being used. This included the removal of about ten trees, haul out wood and chip brush. Set sixteen 6x6 posts and cemented in place. By the end of the week, the roof was on with some finishing left to do.

Completion of Birch 1 Cabin inside. Mudding and sanding ceilings. Put on primer coat of paint. Put new faucets in two showers. Painted bathrooms and shower rooms.

Pressure wash and paint the White Oak Cabin.

Pressure wash and stain office deck.

Build pad for charcoal grills.

Waterfront work included installation of boat docks. Put in place two swimming piers and the swimming raft. Took the sailboats, paddleboats and other waterfront toys out of storage.

Hauled wood chips to replenish the wood chips below playground equipment.

Built PVC rack in cooler to replace broken one.

Cleaning and window washing in two shower houses. Also in Wild Wood Shelter, three small Birch Cabins and four Ash Cabins.

Raked and hauled out many loads of leaves. Sawed down and cleaned up dead trees by the volleyball court.

Welded and built a new rack on the camp sander (used to sand roads in the winter).

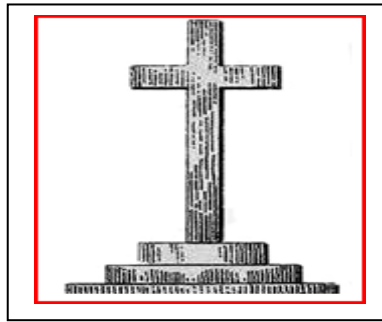
